Orthopedic impairment

Also known as physical disability
Definition: A significant physical limitation that
impairs the ability to move or to complete motor
activities

- •May result from congenital anomaly, disease, accident, or other cause
- defines orthopedic impairments as diseases or disorders that are related to the bones, joints, and/or muscles.

Causes

- genetic abnormality
- disease
- injury
- birth trauma
- amputation
- burns

other causes:

- Diabetes
- Nervous system disorders
- Traumatic spinal cord injury
- Stroke

Types of orthopedic impairments

- ➤ Cerebral Palsy
- Muscular Dystrophy
- **≻**Kyposis
- **≻**lordosis
- **≻**Scoliosis
- Spinal Cord Injury
- Bone Diseases
- > Joint diseases
- ➤ Brachial Plexus Palsy
- ➤ Poliomyelitis
- > Spina Bifida
- ➤ Clubfoot etc.

Classification of impairment

1.Neuromotor impairments: involve the central nervous system (brain, spinal cord, or nerves that send impulses to muscles) affect a child's ability to move, use, feet, or control certain parts of the body e.g. spina bifida, cerebral palsy, and spinal cord injuries

Musculoskeletal disorders

2. Musculoskeletal Disorders:

- Skeletal system impairments that involve the joints, bones, limbs, and associated muscles
- include defects or diseases of the bones and muscles, such as limb deficiency or clubfoot.
- **3.Degenerative diseases** those that affect motor movement such as muscular dystrophy

Common Orthopedic surgeries:

- Open reduction and internal fixation
- Close reduction and internal fixation
- ➤ Joint replacement :
- knee joint replacement
- hip joint replacement
- Shoulder joint replacement
- Elbow joint replacement
